- Discuss the new format of the English version of "at Drop" monthly calendar.

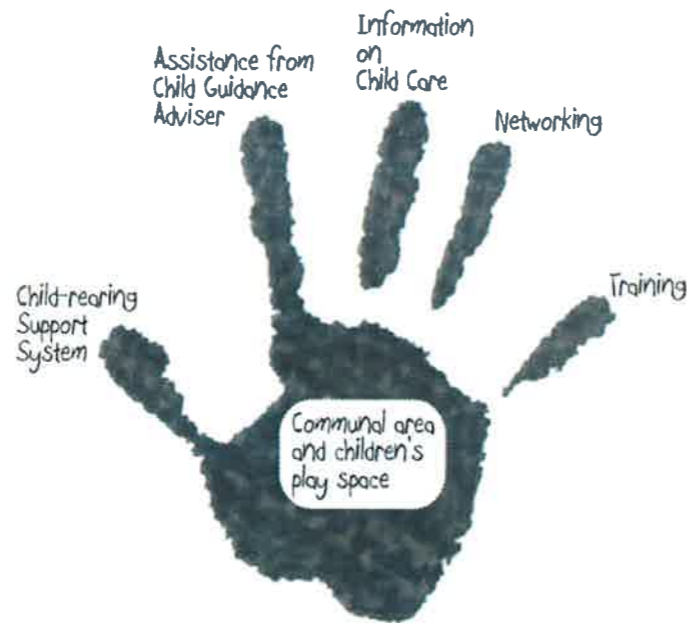

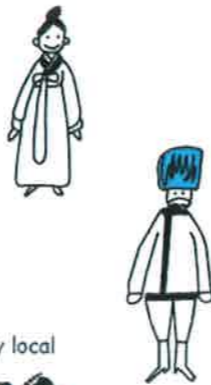
Welcome to DROP!
